








TO DANIEL INTERPRETS THE WRITING

NO FEAR | ONLY FAITHFULNESS

As far as we can extract from the Word of God, Daniel did not suffer from the sin of fear of men. His fear was directed toward God. This was evident as he faithfully maintained his loyalty to the Words of God while translating & interpreting the handwriting on the wall. The fact is, to deliver messages directly from God, the prophet must fear NO one except God, say it as God spoke it, and deliver the message no matter the cost of doing so. As with all prophets of the Lord, 100% obedience to delivering God's message is essential.

THE INTERPRETATION

God is always focused. He manifests Himself again to reveal that He is the true God, the God of the Hebrews, purposed to make known His position and remind emperors that He is the Superior over all humanity.
