
But, beloved, we are convinced of better things concerning you, and things that accompany salvation, though we are speaking in this way. For God is not unjust so as to forget your work and the love which you have shown toward His name, in having ministered and in still ministering to the saints. And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence so as to realize the full assurance of hope until the end, so that you will not be sluggish, but imitators of those who through faith and patience inherit the promises. (Heb 6:9-12)

GOD KNOWS THE AND US

While the norm is the primary leader is the one who receives the credit, this is not how God functions. As in our story, Nehemiah was the brunt of distress, difficulties & persecution. The Lord designs leaders to bear up when suffering unjustly. Those who never reach the spotlight can do their job without the worry of processing the attention that comes with being in the spotlight. However, relax; you are not anonymous to God. This introduces the secondary primary fact, every labor done in love is remembered by God. It's never overlooked or forgotten.



In our passage today, the people have gathered to dedicate the recently completed wall. The city is slowly beginning to shape with signs of progress – new homes, new businesses, and the whole gamut of Jerusalem's new successes. However, this doesn't excuse that times were still difficult. But, as any quality leader knows, stopping to celebrate existing successes is needed to ignite the excitement of future progress.



NEVER STOP SINGING

And do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, but be filled with the Spirit, speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord; always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to God, even the Father; and be subject to one another in the fear of Christ. (Eph 5:18-21)



THE SECRET TO JOY

The Kingdom to Come

Joy is never dependent on happiness, and joy is dependent on the strength of the Lord. Meaning it does not depend upon outward circumstances but upon inward strength & focus. However, if joy IS dependent on circumstances, it isn't true joy; it's happiness, which comes and goes like the winds of doctrines.
