



AMERICA'S HAMAS

Judge Mark T. Boonstra



This week marks two years—TWO YEARS!—since Hamas terrorists massacred thousands of Israelis and foreign nationals and kidnapped hundreds more.

According to the American Jewish Committee, forty-eight of the hostages (including two Americans) taken into captivity in Gaza on October 7, 2023 remain Hamas prisoners (although some are believed to already be dead), continuing to suffer physical abuse,

starvation, psychological torment, and isolation.

Two years . . . 730 days . . . and counting.

Even the American hostages taken captive in Iran in 1979 were released after 444 days.

The Golden Rule ("do to others what you would have them do to you") (Matthew 7:12) notwithstanding, unimaginable cruelty toward others remains alive and well.

And it apparently knows no bounds.

Worse, it is not confined to Gaza. Or the Middle East.

It's here in America too.

There has been a dramatic uptick of political violence in America in recent years.

Attempted assassinations of Republican Congressmen. A successful assassination of a corporate executive. Two attempted assassinations of the current President of the United States. An attempted assassination of a United States Supreme Court Justice. The recent successful assassination of Charlie Kirk. Mass shootings targeting Christians. The indiscriminate slaughter of children at Christian schools and parishioners worshipping in their churches. Shootings targeting federal law enforcement agents seeking to enforce the law. Riots. Smash-and-grabs. Burning vehicles. Takeovers of federal buildings and city blocks by Antifa thugs.

The list goes on and on

Some claim that this scourge of political violence occurs equally across the political spectrum.

It's not true. The facts prove otherwise.

The violence is coming from the Left. The Left's recurring and deadly acts of political violence vastly dwarf (by an ever-increasing order of magnitude) any occasional acts of violence by

fringe right-wingers (which in any event are immediately and roundly condemned by all). Yet the Left continues to stoke the fires of hate, tacitly and implicitly encouraging and inciting the very violence they sometimes pretend to condemn.

What's behind this?

It's the same evil mentality that fuels the Hamas terrorists in Gaza.

This, indeed, is America's Hamas.

Hamas seeks to eradicate the State of Israel. Not peaceful coexistence. Not a constructive dialogue. Not a negotiated resolution of issues. It uncompromisingly demands the death of its neighbors.

The radical Left in America is equally uncompromising. And similarly motivated.

Its lip-service toward tolerance notwithstanding, the Left is singularly intolerant of anyone who does not subscribe to its twisted ways of thinking.

For all its talk about "choice," the only choice it truly favors is the choice to kill unborn babies. It opposes parental choice in education, rejects healthcare choice in vaccines or alternative treatment options, and even denies us choice in deciding whether to attend church or family gatherings (especially if unmasked) when the government deigns to decree it unlawful. It forbids you the right to think and speak in ways that it does not approve.

And the Left is not interested in dialogue. Or a negotiated resolution of issues. It uncompromisingly demands capitulation and surrender. It seeks to intimidate and coerce, censoring and canceling those who do not comply.

Those who profess to decry authoritarianism are, in actuality, the true authoritarians.

And when the American people reject its increasingly bizarre rhetoric and extreme positions, the Left refuses to accept the results. And has the audacity to proclaim that its efforts to flaunt the will of the American voter are somehow required to save democracy.

Despite—or perhaps because of—the Left's duplicity and double-speak, it has lost the argument.

So, what now is its recourse?

Does it accept that it has strayed from mainstream thinking? And from common sense? Much less from Biblical truth? Does it learn from its mistakes? Does it reengage with dialogue? Does it revamp or revise its positions? Does it return to truth?

Not a chance.

It digs in its heels. It lashes out. It refuses to listen to reason.

And when nothing else works, it has a temper tantrum.

It resorts to violence.

That is what we are experiencing in America today.

And it cannot be tolerated.

Our society depends on our adherence to the rule of law.

Free speech? Absolutely!

Political violence? Absolutely not!

The anarchy of political violence being unleashed on America today must be dealt with surely and swiftly. It must be met with strength and fortitude. It simply cannot be allowed.

Americans need and deserve a societal environment in which they are free to live their lives as they see fit, to exercise their right to pursue "life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness," and to speak their minds according to their own values, all with assurances of safety and security. And this requires a system of laws that enforce their right to do so.

Appeasement is not the answer. If we have learned anything in our history, it is that appeasement does not work.

Surrendering one's core values, and caving in to cultural pressure, leads at best to a temporary respite from the ravages of the storm. While creating an illusion of peace, it merely emboldens the forces of darkness, encouraging them to fight another day.

After all, accepting a middle ground between good and evil only leads us that much closer to evil. And it makes truth appear negotiable.

It's not.

As a wise Solomon once observed, "Like a muddled spring or a polluted fountain is a righteous man who gives way before the wicked." (Proverbs 25:26.)

The evil in our midst must therefore be confronted, not mollified. As the Apostle Paul wrote, "Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers. For what partnership has righteousness with lawlessness? Or what fellowship has light with darkness?" (2 Corinthians 6:14-15.) After all, "a little leaven leavens the whole lump." (Galatians 5:9.)

In these dark times, we must remember that "because lawlessness will be increased, the love of many will grow cold. But the one who endures to the end will be saved." (Matthew 24:12-13.)

So let us endure to the end. Let us go forth to steadfastly confront evil, to stand firm for truth, to put an end to the political violence, and to endeavor to reinstill in the evildoers the Golden Rule

maxim of "do[ing] to others what you would have them do to you" (Matthew 7:12) and to "love your neighbor as yourself." (Galatians 5:14.)

CONSULTING WITH MYSELF

Dr. Stephen Phinney

Scripture records that "I consulted with myself" (Nehemiah 5:7), revealing a man who governed his emotions before governing others. His restraint was not weakness—it was strength under submission to God. Nehemiah's leadership teaches us that self-control is not

merely the absence of anger, but the presence of discernment, humility, and Spirit-led conviction. To walk as he did is to lead with clarity in chaos, to build with integrity amid corruption, and to reflect the character of Christ in every decision.

MY STORY

My childhood was marked by a paradox—an absence of self-control masked by a relentless drive to control others. I learned early how to manipulate environments, steer conversations, and assert dominance, not out of strength, but out of a deep need to feel secure in a world that often felt unstable. Anger, fear, and pride became tools I wielded to maintain order on my terms. While others saw leadership, what they often missed was the internal chaos—the lack of restraint, the impulsive reactions, and the unspoken desperation to be seen, heard, and obeyed. Control became my currency, and I spent it freely, unaware that it was costing me the very peace I longed for.

Yet even in that season, God was planting seeds of conviction. The contrast between external control and internal obedience began to stir within me.

I saw the damage done by unchecked emotion and the hollowness of influence rooted in fear. Slowly, the Spirit began to reveal that true leadership isn't about mastering others—it's about mastering yourself. The journey from manipulation to maturity was painful, but necessary. And through it, I discovered that self-control is not weakness—it is the strength to choose restraint when reaction feels easier, and to lead with integrity when control tempts compromise. That revelation became the turning point, shaping the leader I am today.

My obsession with "Not but Christ" was born from the ashes of my own weakness—a lifetime of striving to control, to lead, to be enough in my own strength. I had mastered the art of influence, but not the discipline of internal obedience. The more I tried to shape the world around me, the more I realized how fractured my inner world had become. It was in that

brokenness that the Spirit whispered the truth: "It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me" (Galatians 2:20). That revelation didn't just correct my theology—it redefined my identity. I saw that true leadership, true peace, and true power could only flow from a life crucified with Christ. "Not but Christ" became more than a phrase—it became my lifeline, my compass, and my cry. In every weakness, He proved strong. In every surrender, He proved sufficient. And in every moment of dying to self, I found the resurrection of purpose.

GODLY SELF-CONTROL

Biblically, self-control is not merely a moral discipline—it is a divine manifestation of Yeshua dwelling within the believer. Galatians 5:22–23 lists self-control as a fruit of the Spirit, meaning it is not produced by human effort alone but by the indwelling presence of Christ. When Yeshua lives in us, His nature begins to shape our responses, our desires, and our decisions. Self-control, then, is not the suppression of passion but the sanctification of it. It is the evidence that the Messiah is reigning over the impulses of the flesh and replacing them with the character of heaven.

This truth is stated in Titus 2:11–12, which declares that the grace of God teaches us to deny ungodliness and worldly lusts, and to live soberly, righteously, and godly in this present age. Grace is not passive—it is power in action. It is the active presence of Yeshua enabling us to say "no" to sin and "yes" to righteousness. The believer who walks in self-control is not simply disciplined; he is Spirit-led. His restraint is not rooted in fear or pride, but in love and reverence for the One who lives within him. As Paul wrote in Galatians 2:20, "It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me." That indwelling life is the source of true mastery over the flesh.

Yeshua Himself modeled perfect self-control. In the wilderness, He resisted Satan's temptations not by sheer willpower, but by wielding the Word of God with precision and trust (Matthew 4:1–11). On the cross, He restrained legions of angels and endured suffering with divine patience. His life was not reactive—it was proactive. When His Spirit fills us, we begin to reflect that same restraint, not as a burden but as a blessing. Self-control becomes a testimony that Christ is alive in us, governing our emotions, guiding our choices, and glorifying the Father through every surrendered moment.

Self-control, as a manifestation of Yeshua within, is foundational to biblical servant leadership.

A servant leader is not driven by impulse, ego, or the need to dominate, but by the Spirit of Christ who governs the heart with wisdom, restraint, and love. Jesus Himself modeled this perfectly—He led with authority, yet never with arrogance. He rebuked injustice, yet never retaliated in pride. His leadership was marked by self-restraint, even in the face of betrayal, mockery, and suffering. In John 13, He washed the feet of those who would abandon Him,

showing that true leadership begins with humility and ends in sacrificial service. Without self-control, leadership becomes manipulation; with it, leadership becomes ministry.

Nehemiah exemplified this connection. Though he held a position of influence, he never used it for personal gain. When provoked by enemies or confronted with internal corruption, he responded with prayerful patience and strategic action—not emotional reaction. His ability to govern himself allowed him to govern others with justice and compassion. Biblical servant leadership demands this kind of Spirit-led restraint. It is not passive—it is powerful. It is the ability to lead with clarity in chaos, to speak truth without venom, and to serve without seeking recognition. When self-control flows from the indwelling life of Yeshua, leadership becomes a reflection of heaven—marked by grace, anchored in truth, and driven by love.

Here is your challenge—one that cuts through the noise and calls leaders to rise with conviction:

If self-control is a fruit of the Spirit, then its absence is not a flaw in personality—it's a fracture in surrendered obedience.

We live in a time when leadership is often loud, reactive, and self-serving. But biblical servant leadership demands something deeper: restraint that flows from reverence, decisions shaped by prayer, and authority anchored in humility. Nehemiah didn't lead by impulse—he led by intercession. He didn't build with bravado—he built with brokenness and resolve.


YESHUA'S SECOND COMING


